



GECKOS

You may find geckos in your room, they eat insects, including mozzies and are harmless.



FROGS

Kakadu's frogs are extremely well adapted to the region's climatic extremes. Often friendly and cute green tree frogs can be found living in and around the air-conditioner drainage as well as under the toilet rim!



POWER

Aurora Kakadu is of course located in a remote wilderness area, as such we have no services as is taken for granted in towns and cities. For example, we generate our own electricity using 3 large diesel generators. We kindly ask that you minimise your energy consumption to help protect the environment whilst enjoying your stay.



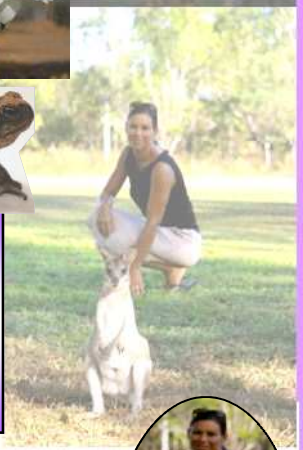
WATER QUALITY

A stay in the Outback of Australia would not be complete without experiencing 'bore water'. Our water is sourced from a bore on the property. Bore water is safe but very corrosive as you will notice by its effects on bathroom fittings. Water for cooking is collected from rainwater and 2 bottles of spring water is supplied per room for drinking.



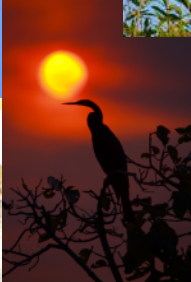
CANE TOADS

Cane toads have been in Kakadu since 2001 and have had a serious impact on some wildlife. They have toxic secretions and should be avoided.



INSECTS

Kakadu supports more than 10,000 types of insects, such as dragonflies, grasshoppers, beetles and moths. Do not leave your doors open in the evening and keep lights to a minimum.



MOSQUITOES

Whilst we endeavour to keep mozzies under control, being near wetlands they are abundant. At dusk and dawn, dress accordingly and use insect repellent.
